

# **Bechtel Nevada**

## **I. Summary Description**

Proposals and contracts contain mandatory clauses discussing Safety, ISMS, and Work Control. Also required is a copy of the proposer's Safety and HazCom Programs with the proposal. Additionally, proposers are informed that a company EMR rating exceeding 1.0 may be grounds for disqualifying their proposal. Their responses to the foregoing are reviewed and may or may not be scored for the technical evaluation; however, lack of a Safety Program is usually grounds for immediate rejection of a proposal. Finally, after the vendor is selected, they are still required to submit additional information specific to this site and the task at hand.

Subcontracts at Bechtel Nevada are managed using a graded approach. The larger subcontracts require the subcontractor to have a site-specific Safety Plan, a Safety Manager, a Superintendent, a Work Control Plan, a HazCom program, etc. Bechtel Nevada then assigns an Subcontract Technical Representative and Safety Representative to this subcontract. On smaller efforts, the subcontractor's safety plan is more simplistic, and they usually follow the Work Control Program designed by Bechtel Nevada. At this level, Bechtel Nevada has a Technical Representative who usually represents Bechtel Nevada in all functional areas because the scope is too small to involve a large group of people. Additionally, Bechtel Nevada collects and evaluates safety and personnel data from every on-site vendor on a monthly basis.

Subcontracts are closed out after all work has been accomplished and all required documents have been submitted. This can include final technical data, Safety Reports, Payrolls. One copy goes in the subcontract file and another copy is retained for future use to document "Past Performance" when evaluating the subcontractor for future subcontracts. Forms have been developed for the collection of this information.
