History:

- An FMC in place, in some form, since 1993
- Institutionalized in the Deputy Secretary Delegation of Authority in 1999
- Assumed its current form December 6, 2007



FIELD MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Field Management Council (FMC) is to provide a forum for discussion of cross-cutting issues that affect field operations. When these discussions identify a problem or an opportunity to optimize mission accomplishment, the FMC develops an analysis as well as recommendations for management action. The FMC also provides the field managers with an opportunity for discourse with the Department's Senior Management.



FIELD MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

SPONSORSHIP:

“As Chief Operating Officer, and as Chair of the Field Management Council, be responsible for corporate program integration, the integration of support activities, with line programs, and review of all staff and support office policy and guidance that affect the field. The authority may not be redelegated.”

FIELD MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

Charter:

- Established Membership, including the Associate Under Secretaries for Energy and Science as well as the Associate Principal Deputy Administrator, NNSA
- Created an Executive Committee (EC)
- Mandated Quarterly EC Meetings and a minimum of 1 full FMC meeting annually
