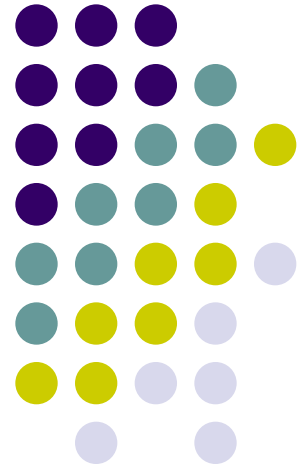

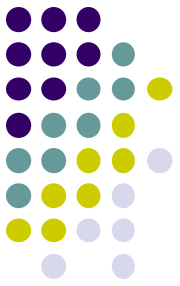

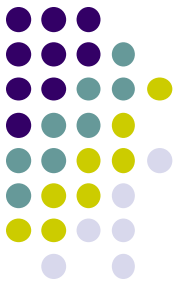


Enforcement Coordination Working Group

- FY 2011 Significant Accomplishments
 - Planned and conducted joint fall meeting with Contractor Assurance Working Group at Lawrence Livermore National Lab (LLNL) in October 2010
 - Conducted joint meeting with DOE HSS Enforcement Workshop and S&S Working Group in Las Vegas during April 2010 (attended by 144 participants)
 - Developed best practice regarding contractor participation in enforcement conferences
