

- Identify the initiating event if any
- Identify the size of the audience to the event
 - Expand to the size of the affected group
- Determine the existence and extent of any “chilling effect”
 - Interviews
 - Document Reviews
 - Observations
 - What proof is needed?
 - Frozen employees
