Mr. Clawson has 30 years of experience as a Project Engineer and Project Manager with extensive expertise in design and construction of facilities in the nuclear weapons complex. He was the Project Manager and Senior Oversight Manager for major projects including the Advanced Size Reduction Facility (\$10M), Consolidated Nuclear Manufacturing Facility (\$46M), Plant Fire and Security Alarms Replacement (\$62M), Protective Clothing Decontamination Facility (\$5M), Plutonium Facility Utility Restoration Project (\$35M), Small Wind Energy Systems Test Site (\$5M), and multiple other infrastructure projects. Over a 15 year period Mr. Clawson was a Lead Manager in a central project management organization with assignments as oversight for other Project Manager or as the Administration Manager for reporting, estimating, and project systems. He is currently the resident Readiness Oversight Leader for the Building 779 Closure Project, which is the first major effort to decommission and demolish a Plutonium production facility within the DOE complex. Mr. Clawson is also an associate instructor for the Project Manager Certification Program at Colorado State University.
